In January of each year, the Health Issues Committee presents a program in which several highly qualified speakers discuss the laws affecting medical plans.

- **Our first speaker is Cindy Stamer, an ERISA lawyer with the Dallas office of Locke Liddell & Sapp LLP. Ms. Stamer will discuss recent legislation that will affect employers who sponsor plans as well as those professionals who administer benefit plans.**
- **Our second speaker is Gail McDonald. Gail is a founder and principal of Transition Resources, Inc. and a former SVP of Human Resources for Ryder System in Miami. Gail serves as the Chairman of the Coordinating Committee on Health and Retirement for The Business Roundtable, a Washington-based association; composed of approximately 200 CEOs of large corporations. Her topic will be the changes that are likely to be proposed in this session of Congress, and the types of initiatives that employers around the country are taking to enhance health care quality for their employees.**
- **Jarel Gibson will be our third speaker. He is the President of HRAS, Human Resources Administrative Solutions, and administers COBRA, HIPAA, and cafeteria plans. He will be speaking about what employers as plan sponsors need to do to comply with current law. His strategic partner is Art Mueller, a former IRS agent who specialized in 401(a) and Section 125 cafeteria plans. Art will be on hand to talk about the changed 415 limits as well as to answer questions from the audience.**
