In the early years, as the members of the bar increased, but the group still remained small, several true "characters" practiced law in Dallas. One remained small, several true characters patients product such character was Bud Crane, a folksy, genial courthouse lawyer who could wore bib overalls to court and was probably the only lawyer who could get away with it. In those days, there were two large brass spittoons in front of every jury box. Bud's favorite tactic - to lower the morale of his opposition and distract the jury – was to take aim from several feet and squirt a stream of spittle directly into the spittoon which rang like a bell!

At times Bud Crane was the epitome of directness and brevity. One brief to the Court of Appeals consisted of a short letter: "The facts are in the record, and you know the law. The case ought to be reversed." And it was.
